**THIRD DISTRICT SUPERVISOR:** Steve Reyes. Code enforcement and quality of life issues. Ignacio Nunez, Chief of CE: CE officer participated in Operation Hammerstrike to keep up on the issue and to get involved in the abatement process. Re: abandoned grows. 16 abatements, 326 tons of trash; 122 hoop houses. Sending notices to property owners and encourage property owners to abate property on their own.

Re: street vendors. Do sweeps with sheriff and health dept. Newsom decriminalized street vending so now they "counsel" them, educate them. New program: public health will begin to confiscate the food to deter them from their programs. Re Community Cleanup. Set up at LVM to collect trash, bulky items, waste tires, e-waste. Re: Work Release program that goes around communities and deal with illegal dumping.

Code Enforcement process. File a complaint and can do it anonymously. Best to leave name and phone number so you can be contacted if needed. Once they confirm violation they send out a Notice of Violation. Work with property owner. Give them 30 days to mitigate and may give an extension. If no progress, 2<sup>nd</sup> citation, then \$500 for third citation. Can issue a criminal violation. Can file a civil complaint.

Chuck: Abatement Ordinance now passed. Will that speed up the abatements? Answer: will still prioritize the cases and deal with them accordingly
